Rules and Regulations

1. All registrations with payments included must be received by the gun club before scheduling your team. Scheduling will be first come/first served by postmarked date.
2. Checks made out to Door County Rod and Gun Club - **\$40** per person which includes the daily membership.

3. 100 target tournament with 3 divisions – High School (grades 9-12), Middle School (grades 6 – 8), Open Division (Any Combination of Grade Levels)
4. Squads will be scheduled in 15-minute intervals. Squads will rotate through 4 different traps starting at trap #1. (25 targets at each trap house) Depending on how many teams we get; *we may have to start shooting at 8:00 a.m.*
5. Team Scoring - Top 5 scores will be taken from each team to determine winners and placement in each of the team divisions.
6. Individual Scoring – Top 3 individual scores will be awarded in each division.
7. ATA safety guidelines
8. Ties – We will use the Reverse Run method for determining ties.
9. Shoot offs – Shoot offs will occur when all shooting is completed for the tournament. All shoot offs will be conducted at the 27-yard line in a sudden death format. A coin flip will occur to determine station selection for shooters.
10. Each team needs a team rep or coach to follow or be present while their squad(s) are shooting. All coaches/ reps will remain behind the boundaries unless needed to help a team member with gun or ammo malfunctions.
- 11. All teams are asked to be present one hour prior to their scheduled shooting time.**
